



Sieimmastua

Information and rules of use



About the cabin

Sieimmastua was built in 2016 in cooperation between the Reisa National Park Board, Halti National Park Center and the state landowner (Statskog). It is financed through grants and own efforts from those mentioned above and a significant part from Statskog.

The cabin is owned by the National Park Board for Reisa National Park and the Ráisduottarháldi landscape protection area and is part of the network of cabins and facilities in and around Reisa National Park.

Cabin details, equipment, and facilities

Beds and equipment for	2-4 persons
Area	12m ²
Distance from plowed road	10 km
Pets allowed	Yes (see rules of use)
Heating	Wood stove (wood available on site)
Power	No
Toilet	Outdoor toilet
Water	Must be retrieved from the stream by the cabin or the Reisaelva river
Cooking facilities	Gas stove
Bed linen / sleeping bag	Must be brought by the visitor, mattresses available
Kitchen utensils	Some cooking utensils. Tableware is brought by the visitor
Other	Washbasins, brooms, detergents, etc. is available
Mobile coverage	No

Note. The tenant must remember to bring their own matches, tea lights, consume paper (toilet and paper towels).

Rent rules

In the main season June-September it is usually not possible to rent the cottage for more than two consecutive days. This is to give more users the opportunity to rent the cabin.

Maintenance fee

The price for renting the entire cabin is **EUR 48 (NOK 480) per night**.

This is just to cover costs for operation and maintenance of the cabin.


Directions – summer

Hike along the Nordkalott Trail that follows along the Reisaelva river from Saraelv (9 km). Or, hike along the forest road to Käyräniva (5 km) and further along the path in the forest to Sieimma (4 km). Map and hike description can be found on www.ut.no. It is also possible to get to Sieimma using a river boat.

Directions - winter

Skiing along Reisaelva from the turning point by Saraelv (11 km). Be aware that accessibility on the river can vary greatly with weather, snow, ice, and temperature conditions. Or, ski

along the forest road to Käyräniva (5 km) and further along the path in the forest to Sieimma (4 km). Map and description can be found on www.ut.no.



There is also an open cabin on the east side (Sieimmastua) of the Reisaelva river that is open to everyone. The distance between the cabins is less than 100 meters, but Reisaelva must be crossed. In the summer season there is a small rowing boat available in the area for crossing the river.

There are two hiking routes to Sieimma. Maps are posted on signs at the starting points.

Rules of use for Sieimmastua

Because of the distance, it is not possible for the cabin owner to supervise after each use. It is in everyone's interest that the cabin is kept in good condition and that the cabin is cleaned well, therefore tenants are required to do the following:

1. The cabin must be cleaned before departure. Cups, cutlery, and utensils that have been used must be washed and dried and put in place. The floor must be brushed and washed. Use washbasins marked for the purpose.
2. Garbage and waste. All waste must be taken back. We do not want extra foods etc. to be left behind.



3. Windows must be closed, and all exterior doors must be locked on departure.
4. Errors or omissions are reported to the owners as soon as possible after the visit. Either by oral feedback in connection with the return of the key, by e-mail or by telephone.
5. Do not let dogs lie in beds. Do not leave dogs alone in the cabin, in which case use a dog cage. Remember to remove dog manure from the cabin area.
6. Everyone who visits the cabin is encouraged to write their names in the cabin book.
7. Check-in at the cabin from kl. 14:00 and check-out at 11.00 on unless otherwise agreed.

The tenant commits to follow the rules of use. In the event of poor cleaning, damage or destruction of the cabin / equipment, the owner reserves the right to collect additional payment / compensation from the tenant.
